ONLINE PRIVACY POLICY AGREEMENT

This Privacy Policy ("Policy") will help you understand how we collect and use personal information from those who visit our website or make use of our online facilities and services, and what we will and will not do with the information we collect. Our Policy, which is subject to change from time to time, has been designed and created to ensure those affiliated with 6 Degrees Health Dx, LLC of our commitment and realization of our obligation not only to meet, but to exceed, most existing privacy standards.

Use Of Personal Information

Sharing Information With Third Parties

Automatically Collected Information

Information about a customer or user's computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by 6 Degrees Health when the customer or user visit the Site. This information can include:

- 1. 1. An IP address;
- 2. Browser type;
- 3. Domain names; or
- 4. Access times and referring website addresses.

This information is used for the operation of the Site, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Site.

Security Of Personal Information
